



Northbound I-405 ramp closures in Bellevue from Feb. 23-26

Signed detour routes will be in place along Southeast Eighth Street to access downtown Bellevue

DESCRIPTION OF WORK

Travelers on northbound Interstate 405 this weekend should plan ahead and allow extra time for travel. The northbound I-405 off-ramps to Northeast Fourth and Eighth Street (Exit 13A/13B), as well as the Southeast Eighth Street on-ramp to northbound I-405 will be closed from 11:30 p.m. Friday, Feb. 23 to 4 a.m. Monday, Feb. 26.

Crews will demolish a retaining wall under the Main Street bridge on the east side of the highway and install drainage as part of the I-405, Renton to Bellevue Widening and Express Toll Lanes Project.

DETOUR ROUTE INFORMATION

During the closure, drivers will access downtown Bellevue via the Southeast Eighth Street off-ramp.

- To access the east side of downtown Bellevue, travelers will exit at Southeast Eighth Street and head north on 116th Avenue Southeast.
- To access the west side of downtown Bellevue, travelers will exit at Southeast Eighth Street and head north on 112th Avenue Southeast.

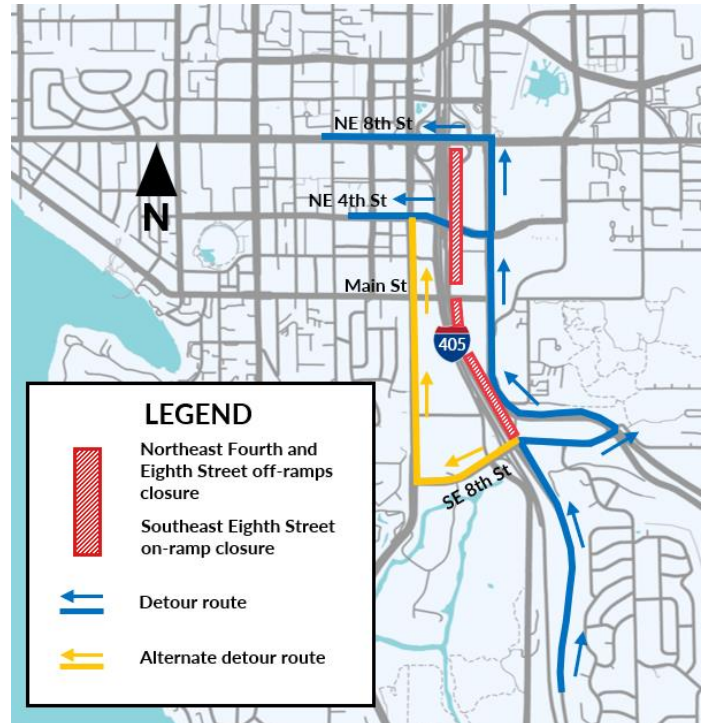
Drivers are encouraged to reduce speeds while traveling through the work zone for the safety of construction crews.
